Pattern Practice Learning about patterns will give your child a head start in math. Try these activities together:

- . Make a block tower, starting with a yellow block, then a blue one, and then another yellow block. Challenge your youngster to keep the pattern going.
- Clap your hands or stomp your feet once, pause, and then clap or stomp twice quickly. Repeat, and see if your child can follow along. Have your child clap or stomp his own pattern.
- Have your youngster make a bracelet by stringing plastic beads or colored cereal rigs on yarn. She can make patterns by alternating colors.

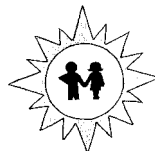
